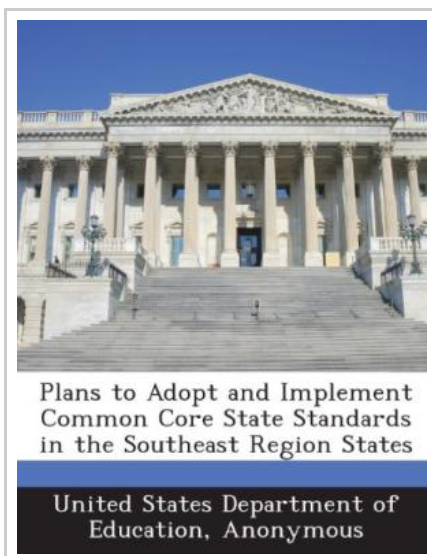

The Common Core State Standards Initiative is a state-led effort to establish a common set of expectations for what K-12 students are expected to know and be able to do in English language arts and math. The Common Core State Standards were released in June 2010. As of November 2011, 45 states, the District of Columbia, and two territories have adopted the standards and were planning to implement them and align assessments to them.



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
