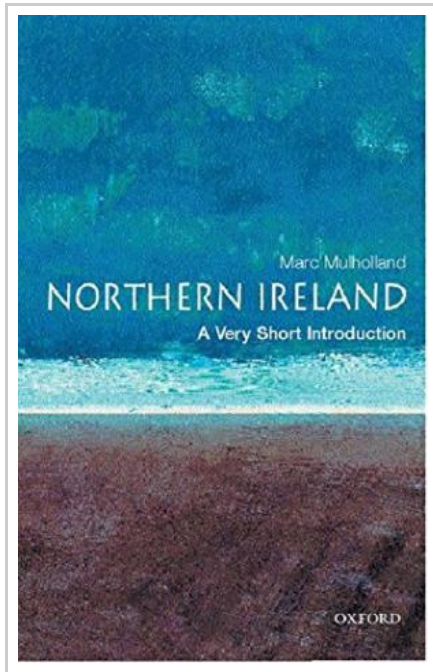




Northern Ireland: A Very Short Introduction
