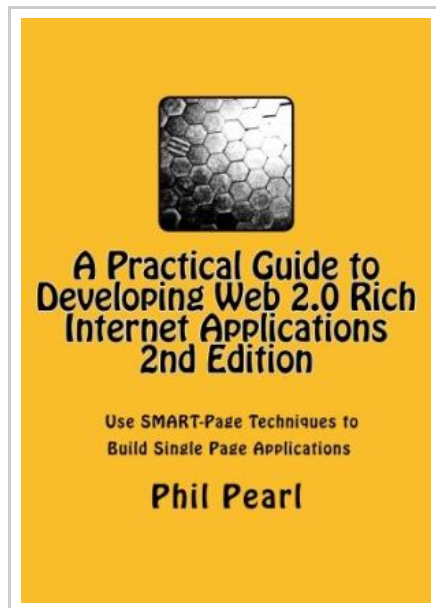

New in the 2nd edition is a chapter on Cyber Security that includes a detailed description of the Stanford JavaScript Crypto Library (SJCL).
