O alternatively, no existen realmente descripciones en el mundo, de ninguna manera, incluso en el espejo. Pero el espejo es rico en ser, precisamente, el reino de las descripciones. Así el hecho substancial de hacer formas en el espejo se vuelve fuente de ilusión. El hombre forma, y es atrapado por sus formas. Por qué es una broma pesada, incluso trágica...
