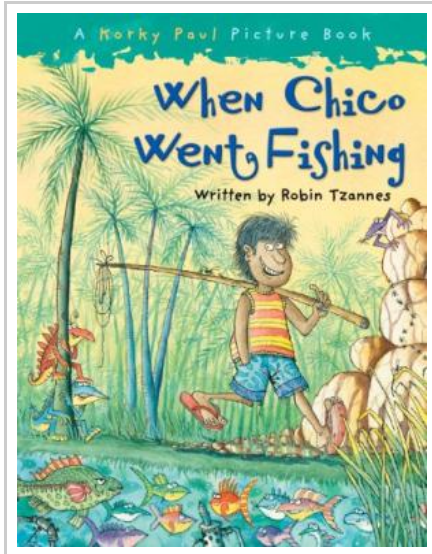




When Chico Went Fishing
