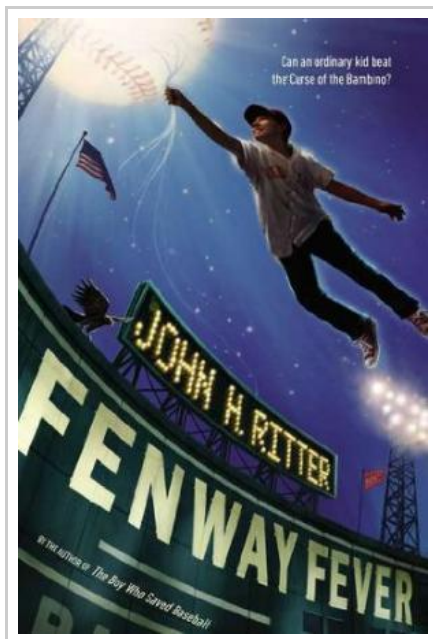




Fenway Fever
